**APPENDIX 2
PRESCRIBED PENALTIES FOR BREACHES OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT**

ONE MATCH PENALTY

- 17.1 These offences are considered 3rd Grade offences. If taken to the Judiciary and found guilty, the penalty may be up to a three match suspension.
- a) Abusive language towards others that is not deemed excessive.
 - b) Smoking whilst on the ground.
 - c) A player may not wear clothing, equipment or footwear that is not approved by the Association.
 - d) Continuing to use excessive swearing, not directed at another person, after first warning by umpire.
 - e) A player or an Official to criticize in or to the media, any aspect of umpiring or, the management of the Association.
 - f) Failure for the appointed Captain to sign the “Umpires Match Report” at the completion of a match .
 - g) Following an umpiring decision a player may ask for clarification but shall not –
 - Dispute the decision;
 - React in a provocative or disapproving manner;
 - Use offensive language to the umpire.
- 17.2 Guideline penalty: minimum first offence one match suspension; second offence 4-match suspension; further offences 8-match suspension

TWO MATCH PENALTY

- 17.3 These offences are considered 2nd Grade offences. If taken to the Judiciary and found guilty, the penalty may be up to a six match suspension.
- a) A player or official must not use crude or offensive language, gestures, or conduct him/her in a way that is detrimental to the game or to the spirit of the game.
 - b) Knocking down the stumps personally or with equipment outside actions of normal play.
 - c) Making obscene gestures to crowd, players or umpires.
 - d) Making deliberate contact with another player in the course of play.
 - e) Throwing of equipment where no damage to person or surrounds eventuates outside actions of normal play.

- f) Taking alcohol on the ground or drinking during the game.
- g) Abusive language towards others that is deemed excessive.

17.4 Guideline penalty: first offence 2-match suspension; second offence 6-match suspension ; further offences 10-match suspension.

FOUR MATCH PENALTY

17.5 These offences are considered 1st Grade offences. If taken to the Judiciary and found guilty, the penalty may be up to a 6 match suspension

- a) A player or official must not engage in racial vilification or racial abuse that may be construed as giving offence to a member of the public or another player or official.
- b) Throwing of equipment where damage to person or surrounds eventuates.
- c) Continual dissent and / or abuse of umpire(s), official, another player or spectator.
- d) Threatening of umpire(s), official, another player or spectator.
- e) Any other report where the umpire considers the offence to be equally significant as the above offences.

17.6 Guideline penalty: First offence 4-match suspension, second offence 10-match suspension; further offences 16-match suspension.

ASSAULT

17.7 A player or official must not assault or attempt to assault, an official, another player, or a spectator.

17.8 Guideline penalty: first offence up to 12 matches suspension; second offence up to two (2) season suspension, third offence consider life suspension.
